

Federal Student Aid

2022–2023

Rutgers students rely on a variety of federal financial aid programs, including Pell Grants, Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants, Work-Study, and Direct Loans, totaling more than \$484 million in 2022–2023. Each of these federal financial aid programs has a significant impact on the ability of Rutgers students to afford their education. **Seventy-five percent** of the students at Rutgers currently receive some form of financial assistance—whether federal, state, private, or institutional support.

From the more than \$85.5 million provided to our almost 16,000 Pell Grant recipients, to more than \$387 million in federal student loans, the federal government’s investment in Rutgers students helps to make their education possible.
